Adverse Drug Events, Adverse Drug Reactions - Medicines have unintended side effects, and if any of these is harmful, the patient has an adverse drug reaction.² The European Medicines Agency (EMA) defines an adverse drug reaction as "a response to a medicinal product which is noxious and unintended."³ This definition now extends beyond the licensed use of a drug to include adverse reactions from off-label use, poisoning, and medication errors. reactions | The BMJ - Allergic drug reactions account for only 5 to 10% of all adverse drug reactions. Any medication has the potential to cause an allergic reaction. Skin reactions (e.g. urticaria, erythema) are the most common form of allergic drug reaction, but can also include cough, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and headaches, and in severe cases can cause ...
